



## Are you a student? Need help paying for tuition?

During the 2010/2011 school year, Manitoba Hydro will be offering 37 awards, bursaries or scholarships to Aboriginal students in Manitoba. This funding is valued at over \$110,000.

Six Generating Futures Scholarships will be awarded this year. They are valued at \$10,000 each and include the option of summer employment in 2011.

To be considered for a Generating Futures Scholarship, you must be of **Aboriginal ancestry, registered as a full-time student, and have a minimum 60% course load** in one of these programs:

### University Degree

- Business (Majoring in Accounting, Finance, Human Resources, or Marketing)
- Engineering (Majoring in Civil, Electrical, or Mechanical)
- Computer Science

### College Diploma

- Civil Engineering Technology
- Computer Engineering Technology
- Electrical Engineering Technology
- Electronic Engineering Technology
- Mechanical Engineering Technology
- Instrumentation Engineering Technology
- Telecommunications Engineering Technology
- Information Systems Technology
- Computer Analyst/Programmer



**To be eligible, applications and supporting documents must be submitted by Friday, October 1, 2010.**

Only complete applications will be considered. A complete application will include:

- completed 3 page application form;
- transcripts from the program, or an acceptance letter for first year students
- proof of Aboriginal ancestry (ie. Status, Treaty, Metis Membership, or Nunavut Certificate Card).
