Assembly of Manitoba Chiefs invites all interested individuals to a conference that will explore the "Unspoken Truth"

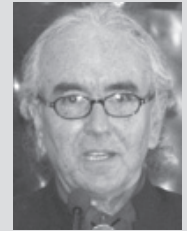
