The Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) Program at Algoma University prepares students for a career in social work practice with individuals, families, groups, organizations, communities, and societies.

The Algoma University BSW program was developed in partnership with colleges in northern Ontario, and has a particular focus on multi-cultural social work in Northern, rural, remote, Indigenous, and Franco-Ontarian communities.

Algoma University has a long tradition of helping college graduates earn their university degrees. Graduates of diploma programs (eg. Social Services Worker) can earn credit for their college diploma, and we will work with you to make the transition to university a smooth one. Graduates of the program will be prepared to practice social work at the entry level with diverse populations in a Canadian context, and will gain a deep awareness of how their personal experiences are embedded in social structures.

The program includes a 700-hour field placement that will link social work concepts, values, and theory to practice.

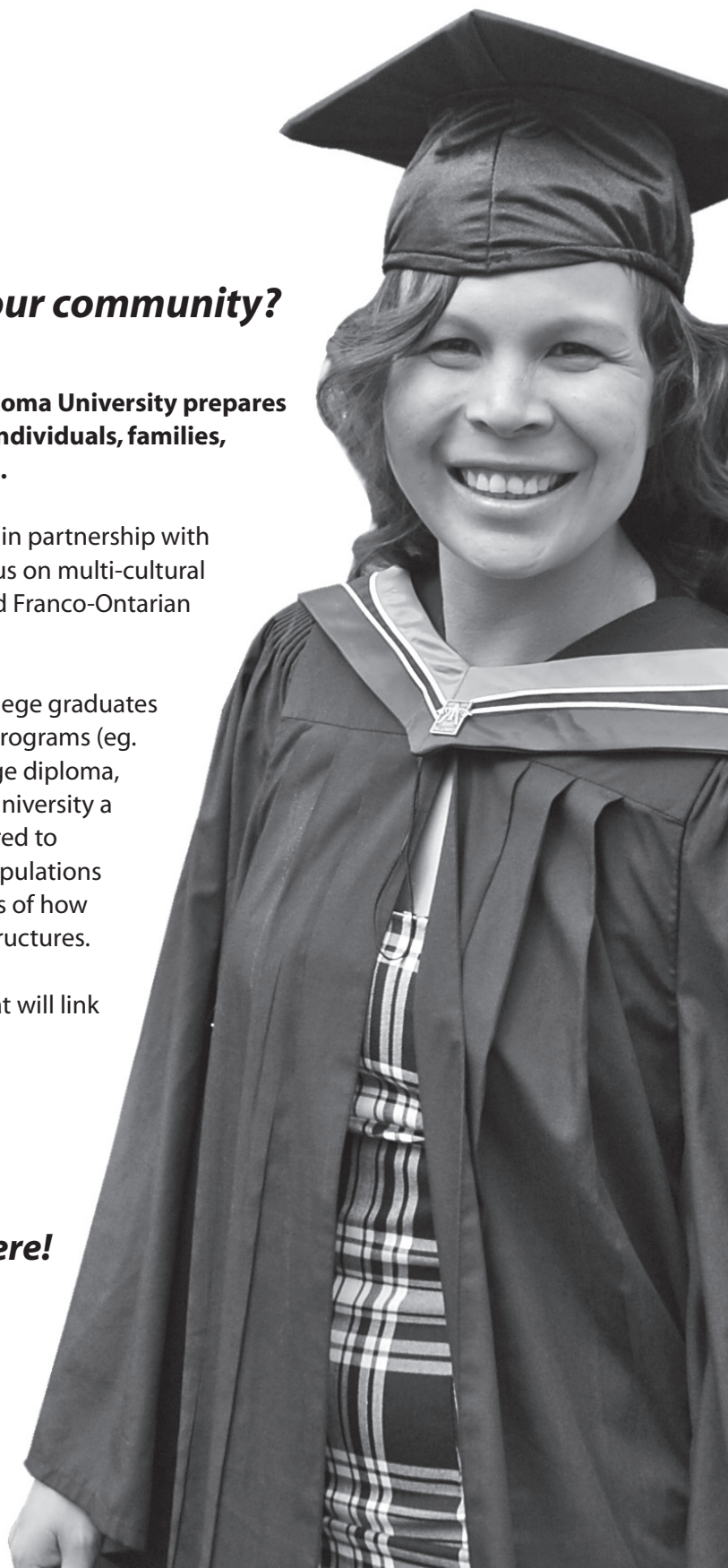
