



Are you a student? Need help paying for tuition?

During the 2011/2012 school year, Manitoba Hydro will be offering 46 awards, bursaries and scholarships to Aboriginal students in Manitoba. This funding is valued at over \$130,000.

Eight \$10,000 Generating Futures Scholarships will be awarded this year. To be considered for a Generating Futures Scholarship, you must be of Aboriginal ancestry, registered as a full-time student, and have a minimum 60% course load in one of the following programs:

University Degree (4 Year Programs)

- Business (Majoring in Accounting, Finance, Human Resources, or Marketing)
- Engineering (Majoring in Civil, Electrical, or Mechanical)
- Computer Science

College Diploma

- Civil Engineering Technology
- Electrical Engineering Technology
- Electronic Engineering Technology
- Mechanical Engineering Technology
- Instrumentation Engineering Technology
- Communications Engineering Technology
- Information Systems Technology
- Computer Analyst/Programmer



To be eligible, applications and supporting documents must be submitted by Friday, September 30, 2011.

Only complete applications will be considered. A complete application will include:

- completed 3 page application form
- resume
- copy of university transcript or an acceptance letter plus copy of Grade 12 transcript for first year students
- proof of Aboriginal ancestry (ie. Copy of Status, Treaty, Metis Membership or Nunavut Certificate card)
