### Maximizing Aboriginal Economic and Social Well-Being Across Canada

Aboriginal Trust assets can be reasonably estimated to be measured in the “billions of dollars” range across Canada. A conservative improvement of 2% in the use of these funds could provide extra millions of dollars back to Aboriginal Communities for enhanced prosperity, programs and services. The National Aboriginal Trust Officers Association (NATOA) through funding from TD Bank Financial Group and Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada, offer the National Aboriginal Trustee Training Program. This On-Line Training Program is designed to empower participants to build their knowledge to make informed decisions on behalf of their communities, now and in the future.

The National Aboriginal Trustee Accreditation Program was introduced through Lethbridge College’s online ANGEL System in January 2011. The Program is offered three times per year & will take the student up to four (4) months to complete the course. This course is designed to offer an introductory basic level look at Aboriginal Trust and Investment issues. The student will understand what Trusts are, how they are implemented, managed and evaluated as well as helpful organizational tactics. Also included is an introductory review of the investment products, markets and industry that will assist the student in becoming a knowledgeable and confident Community Trustee.

The spring program will start on May 27, 2013 and participants have four months from that time to complete all modules, as well as the final case study. Fees are NATOA Member \$500; Non-member \$800.
