In 2012, over 1,400 Aboriginal women participated in a WBF Career Decision Making Workshop. Increasing the participation of Aboriginal women remains a key strategic priority. Aboriginal women comprised 27 per cent of our 2012 graduates and, over the past two years, the number of Aboriginal women who connected with WBF to learn about career opportunities in construction increased by 74 per cent.
