○ Strategic Planning

Principles and concepts that have positive impacts on strategic economic development planning and implementation are presented for discussion, including:

- The ‘5 Ws’ of strategic economic development planning

○ ACED 230 Venture Development II

This course is equivalent to TAED Competency 12 New Enterprise Development and will introduce students to the field of “entrepreneurship”. Students examine the concepts, activities and new ways to meet the needs and demands of entrepreneurs. The course examines these themes: the characteristics of the entrepreneur, family businesses, home-based businesses, new product design, business plan, franchising and other alternatives. There will be a focus on opportunities for entrepreneurial development in Aboriginal communities facing challenges such as: downsizing, restructuring, information and communication technologies and globalization.
